She worked for years in entrepreneurship and small business development at the Vermont Women's Business Center, the Women's Small Business Program, and Vermont Businesses for Social Responsibility.

Before starting her business, Carina represented the interests of working-class families, youth, women, and seniors as a School Board Member, a State Legislator, and a City Councillor. In 2007, she co-founded the Vermont Woodworking School. Over the last decade, as Director, Carina has recruited and led a solid team of staff and faculty who teach about 40 full-time students to become Vermont's next generation of furniture-makers. Carina also co-founded the Greater Burlington Women's Forum, a volunteer-led series of presentations and discussions that provide opportunities for women to connect around shared topics of interest.
